MAN FINED £45. CAIRNS PROSECUTION

James Joseph Richard Wharley, of Spence Street. Waterside worker, was yesterday fined £45, in default three months imprisonment at the Cairns Court of Petty Sessions, for having driven a car on Sunday while under the influence of liquor.

Detective Senior Sergeant W.H. Raetz, who prosecuted, said Wharley had been involved in a collision with another vehicle early on Sunday morning on the Stratford road.

Detective Raetz said the driver of the other vehicle, Ian Malcolm Little, had reported to the police that Wharley had driven away when asked to accompany him to the police station.

Detective Raetz said Constable R. Pradella had walked outside the station and seen a sedan being driven by Wharley from side to side of the road. When the car stopped near the police station, Wharley was questioned and had admitted being involved in an accident with another vehicle. Wharley was unsteady on his feet.

A doctor who examined Wharley was of the opinion that he was under the influence, Detective Raetz said Wharley yesterday told the court he had driven away after the accident when the other driver said he would be better to follow in his car, he reported the accident to the police and later had been questioned and put in the cells He said he had been driving for about 20 years without having been involved in an accident before.

Mr. P. W. Shepherd C.P.S. who heard the case with Mr. G. Hay, JJ», said the number of recent prosecutions should have been sufficient warning of the view taken by the court of such offences Wharley was allowed a month

in which to pay the fine.
